

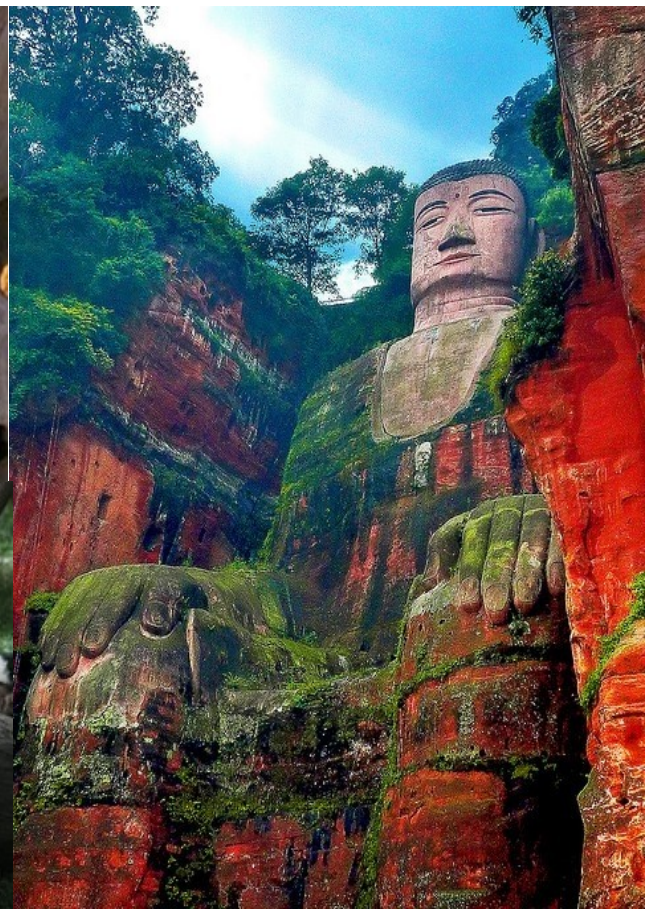

Today you will go to visit Leshan Giant Buddha, the UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1996. The Leshan Giant Buddha was built during the Tang Dynasty (618-907). It is carved out of a cliff face that lies at the confluence of the three in the city of Leshan. It is the largest carved stone Buddha in the world.

Nov 13. Chengdu - Shanghai by flight

You will go to visit the Chengdu Panda Base to see the cute panda. Fly to Shanghai in the afternoon, the largest city in China, and one of the largest metropolitan areas in the world, with over 20 million people

Nov 14. Shanghai

Today you will visit Shanghai Museum in the morning, with an audio tour describing the special features of the museum's permanent collections, the Old downtown and the city's colonial European past at The Bund.

Nov 15. Shanghai – LAX (SFO or New York) by flight (B)
